Clothing/Personal Gear

- Underwear for each day +1
- Long Pants
- Shorts
- T-Shirt for Sat. Eve/Sun. Morn
- Long sleeved top
- Sleepwear
- Socks (ALWAYS pack extra)
- Sneakers/hiking shoes (an extra pair is nice to have) NO SANDALS/CROCS/FLIP FLOPS except in tents!!
- Jacket/hooded sweatshirt
- Bandana (Will be provided & MUST be worn)
- Raincoat or Poncho
- Washcloth, towel, soap, shampoo/conditioner
- Insect Repellent (DO NOT spray in tents)
- Sun Screen (DO NOT spray in tents)
- Equipment for braces/retainers, Glasses/Contact Lenses
- Toothpaste & Toothbrush
- Hairbrush/Comb
- Sanitary Napkins/Tampons
- Extra Trash bag for dirty clothes
- Cinch sak/Backpack

Pack everything in SOFT bags (ex: duffel bag, gym bag, backpack, plastic trash bags.

**Camper's Names Should be
on
EVERYTHING!!!**

Equipment/Gear

- Flashlight (with extra batteries)
- Sleeping bag OR 2 sheets & 2 blankets
- Pillow
- ONE stuffed animal (There is not enough room for multiple stuffed animals)
- Light blanket or sheet
- MESS KIT (Plastic plate, bowl, cup, silverware or "official" mess kit)
- Water Bottle
- Sit-Upon
- Dunk bag to hold mess kit. You can use a mesh laundry bag or old onion bag with a shoe lace threaded through the top. The dunk bag is used to hang and air-dry the mess kit.
- Two one-gallon zip lock bags
- Camera
- Book/Reading Material for quiet time

NO food, candy, gum, breathmints or flavored chapsticks/lip balms. Raccoons & skunks love candy and flavored items as much as girls do!!

NO electric appliances or electronic games/devices. Cell phones are not permitted on the girls at any time. Encampment personnel and GSHPA are not liable should something happen to a cell phone. If your daughter uses her cell phone as a camera, it will be permitted. HOWEVER, if any adult finds the phone being used for ANYTHING other than a camera, it will be taken away & given back when camp ends. Please call your troop leaders for any emergencies!

Medications (in their original container with dosage instructions) must be given to the camp nurse, Suzette, at registration. Please make sure we are aware of ANY allergies to Meds/Food.
